In 1932, the Grosberg-Golub Corporation opened their first supermarket in Green Island. Shortly after, two more stores opened, one in Watervliet and one in Schenectady. They named these stores Central Market, which later changed in 1973 to Price Chopper. Today, Price Chopper is owned by the Golub Corporation and their headquarters are in downtown Schenectady. They operate 137 Price Chopper supermarket stores in upstate New York, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Vermont, Massachusetts, and New Hampshire, all of which are serviced from the same warehouse located in Rotterdam. They have become one of the leading employers in the area. Their primary market is still in the Capital District area where about a third of the stores are located.

Price Chopper is dedicated to providing high quality products for their customers and selling the goods their customers want. In many of their stores you will find artisan bakeries, bagel factories, a kosher store, and added international cheese, sushi, and floral offerings. Additionally, due to customer demand, they recently expanded their natural and organic selections in many of their stores.

SCAP's partnership with Price Chopper began in March 2015 when a Talent Acquisition Specialist from Price Chopper's Headquarters participated in SCAP's Speed Networking sessions at the Schenectady Job Fair held at Proctor's.
