Annual Report 2019


In the 2018-2019 program year at SCAP's Early Learning Program...

- 501 unduplicated children ages 0-5 years old were served.
- of children ages zero to five had an ongoing source of continuous, assessable health care, with 84% up-to-date on a schedule of age appropriate preventive and primary dental care.
- 94 children were supported with special services.
- volunteers, 94% of which were current or former parents, generating more than \$49,433 in in-kind services.
- children transitioned to Kindergarten, with 76% meeting literacy expectations.
- served 83,907 nutritious meals and 37,554 nutritious snacks.
- 480 hours of training offered to 91 staff members.




Budget Breakdown
