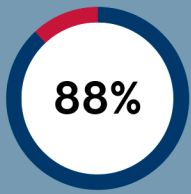
EMERGENCY FUND

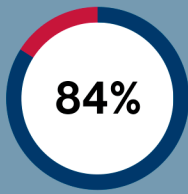
Children Ages 0-5 Meeting or Exceeding Age-Appropriate Skills in Spring/Summer 2023



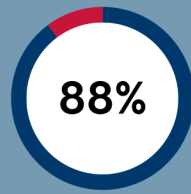

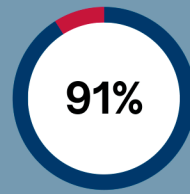

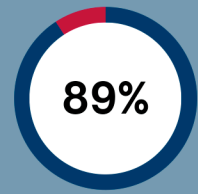

79,013 nutritious meals served to children ages 3-5 and 70 children received free formula while in care

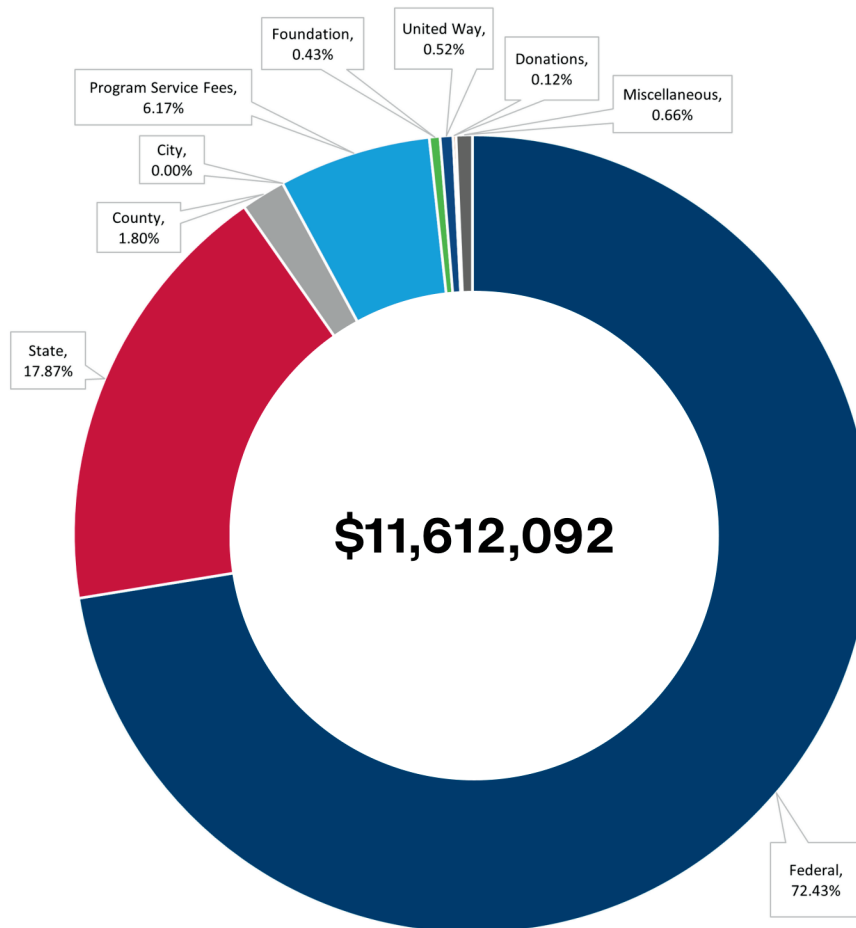
