### **Community Crisis Network**

- Community Resource Navigators at five strategic locations.
- Access emergency housing, food, clothing, household furnishings and other resources.
- Assistance with applications for public assistance, SNAP, SSI/SSDI, and Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP).
- Advocacy with DSS and National Grid.
- Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)
- Mediate disputes between tenant and landlord.

### **Family Resource Center**

- Ongoing intensive case management to help families move out of poverty.

### **Housing Programs**

- Permanent housing for families living with disabilities.
- Transitional housing for homeless mothers and their children.

### **Employment Services**

- Career Readiness Programs.
- Training to re-enter the workforce/change careers.
- Opportunity to enroll in one of our certified occupational careers
- Staff assisted job search, job retention, referrals, and ongoing case management for graduates.
- Mohawk Valley Employer Resource Network (MVERN)

### **Early Learning Programs**

- Comprehensive education for children birth to five years old.
- Specialized services, including: health, nutrition, mental health, occupational therapy, physical therapy, and family development.
- Leads a multi-county child care partnership that combines early learning services with center-based and family child-care services.
- Early Head Start-Child Care Partnerships that improve the quality of existing child care programs and broaden access to high-quality care for low-income infants and toddlers
- Operates four early learning centers for pre-school aged children.
